

## CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The City of Moses Lake is implementing a curbside recycling program and yard waste program beginning August 2<sup>nd</sup>. The following is information regarding your basic garbage service and the curbside and yard waste recycling program.

In addition to your selected garbage cart service you have also received, at no additional cost a 64 gallon recycle cart (blue lid) and your old 96 gallon garbage cart has a sticker on it and is now your yard waste cart (black lid).

\* Senior Citizen rate - you must be 65 years or older, property owner, and living at the property.

If you did not select a garbage cart size by the implementation date of July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010, a 48 Gallon Garbage Cart (grey lid) has been delivered along with the recycle cart. If you selected a different size, it should be delivered with this recycle cart. If you would like to change your garbage cart size please see the following information

### How to Change Your Garbage Cart Size.

This cart will be used for items that can not be included in your Yard Waste or Recyclables carts.

## **YARD WASTE**

### **Cart with Black Lid**

Yard waste service is provided weekly from the 2<sup>nd</sup> full week of March through the 1<sup>st</sup> full week of November. Yard waste service is then provided once a month in December, January and February during the 2<sup>nd</sup> full week of these months. Whole Christmas trees will be accepted in the program during January and February collection weeks only. See the calendar that is enclosed.

**Materials accepted: Anything that grows in the yard**  
Please NO Plastic Bags, Dirt or Rocks

Grass clippings	Leaves	Weeds
Brush	Branches smaller than four inches in diameter	
Christmas trees	Fruit & Vegetables	

**The first pickup for your yard waste will be the week of August 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

## **RECYCLABLES**

### **Cart With Blue Lid**

**Recyclable collection is every other week. Please NO Plastic Bags**

The colored Circle on your Blue Lid will denote the week that your recycle cart will be picked up. The colors are **Red** and **Purple**. Please see the enclosed calendar for your pickup week.

**Red** week will start August 2<sup>nd</sup> and be every other week there after.

**Purple** week will start August 9<sup>th</sup> and be every other week thereafter.

**Materials that can be recycled:**

Newspaper & Inserts, cardboard, aluminum/metal cans, mail, junk mail, magazines, mixed paper, catalogs, plastic bottles (necks smaller than base) and milk-style paper cartons, phone books, milk jugs, paper bags, cereal boxes, paper or frozen food boxes, shredded paper (in a paper bag).

**NO GLASS** is allowed in the recycling cart. Glass can be recycled separately at glass recycling locations in the City of Moses Lake. View the full list at [www.ci.moses-lake.wa.us](http://www.ci.moses-lake.wa.us).

2. Paul Lauzier Athletic Complex by Field #5 (towards Home Depot)
3. Lakeside Disposal & Recycling 2000 West Broadway
4. 700 Penn Street

Garbage, recyclables and yard waste service are all on the same date. For example, if your garbage is picked up on Monday, so are your recyclables (every other week) and yard waste.

- Reminders:**
1. Bag your garbage - not the recyclables or Yard Waste.
  2. Have your Carts out by 6:00 a.m. and no closer to each other than 3 feet.
